



AHCCCS Population Highlights December 2013

The AHCCCS population as of December 1, 2013 was 1,258,142. This figure does not include Healthcare Group enrollment of 5,689 (as of November 1, 2013), the SLMB/Qualified Individual enrollment of 39,008 or Transplant Option 1 & 2 enrollment of 0. Including these populations, the total AHCCCS population is 1,302,839.

- From November 1, 2013 to December 1, 2013, the population decreased 16,132 members or 1%.

New enrollment in the KidsCare program has been frozen since January 1, 2010, due to a lack of funding, and a waiting list of applicants was established. Effective May 1, 2012, through December 31, 2013, AHCCCS will be receiving funding from political subdivisions on behalf of three hospitals participating in the Safety Net Care Pool, which will allow AHCCCS to provide coverage for 21,700 children in KidsCare II. A process was established to contact waiting list members in sequential order and invite them to apply for KidsCare II through Health-e-Arizona. Additionally, SOBRA Children who are currently eligible and are aging out of SOBRA are being transferred to KidsCare II.
